

Funding Priorities – Central Florida

The funding priorities for the Orlando Health Community Grant Program are based on the top needs identified in the 2025 Community Health Needs Assessment. For the Central Florida region (Lake, Orange, Osceola and Seminole counties), there are four overarching funding priority themes, each with specific focus areas:

Economic Stability

Food insecurity, with a focus on affordable, healthy foods

Affordable housing for all, including older adults

Jobs with livable wages

Affordable childcare services

Healthcare Access and Quality

Access to outpatient mental health services

Improved care coordination among healthcare providers

Expanded maternal and prenatal healthcare

Better communication between healthcare organizations and nonprofits

Case management for complex medical and social needs

Programs for chronic disease prevention and education

Behavioral health services for the uninsured

Neighborhood and Built Environment

Accessible transportation for medical appointments and public needs

Social and Community Context

Support for medically underserved populations

Improved health literacy resources

Linguistically and culturally appropriate healthcare services and resources
